Power School is an important educational tool provided to every family of *Christian Heritage School*.

1. *What is Power School?*

“Power School” is our internet-based classroom communication / grading and attendance management system.

2. *Who uses Power School?*

This important management and communication tool is available now to parents and students and teachers.

3. *What is it used for?*

This internet-based program, which is updated by teachers and administrators, allows parents and students to check progress in each class and do so in real time. Grades, assignments, attendance and important information are just a mouse-click away. A link on each class allows users to access additional information on the individual teachers’ classroom pages.

4. *Is it safe?*

In order to ensure privacy, a username and password is listed below to provide encrypted security access when viewing individual student information.
