COVID-19 Response

Christian Heritage School transitioned to distance learning starting on March 18, 2020 until the end of the 2019-2020 school year. For the 2020-2021 school year, we have offered traditional/in-person learning starting September 2, 2020.

Honors (H), Advanced Placement (AP), Dual Credit (DC)

H courses are designed to be taught at an accelerated pace with a more comprehensive score of content. **AP** courses follow the syllabi prescribed by College Board. The content of these courses is commensurate with freshmen college-level courses. **DC** courses are college courses taught by CHS faculty who are also adjunct professors within our partnerships with four-year institutions.

Curricular Remote Instruction School Partnership (CRISP)

Starting in the 2020-2021 school year, Eastern Christian School (NJ), The Master's School (CT), and Christian Heritage School (CT) partnered in a pilot program in which two courses at each school were listed as a remote course offering for students at the other schools.

Diplomas

To graduate with a **Standard Diploma**, students must meet the graduation requirements listed above. To graduate with an **Advanced Diploma**, students must successfully complete five humanities, four STEM, and a total of eleven courses from the Advanced Diploma Course List (ADCL), which consist of AP, DC, and select honors courses. To graduate with an **Advanced Diploma with Distinction**, students must successfully complete six humanities, five STEM, and a total of thirteen courses from the ADCL.

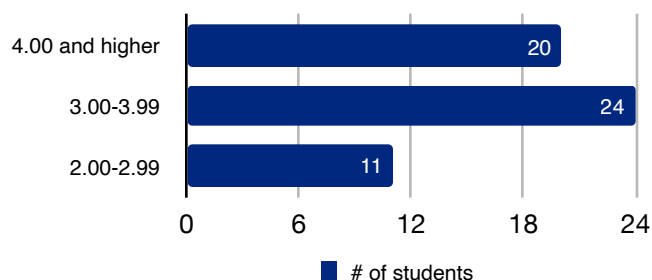
Christian Heritage School is accredited by New England Association of Schools and Colleges (NEASC).
