Students entering Literature and Composition 7

Students will choose one book that appeal to their interest. Parents, please assist your child in choosing books that are the appropriate reading level. The book must be fiction, a book not read before and a length of 150-200 pages (or more).

Age Range: 10 - 12 years, 10 - 14 years

Grade Level: 5 – 7, 6 – 9

After reading, complete the following assignment.

* Write a series of 5 letters (one paragraph each, 8-10 sentences) to any character in the book.

*The letters can be from you, the reader, or you could write a letter from the perspective of a character in the book. You could also write your letters from several character's perspectives.

* Please have the letters move the story along chronologically, choosing important moments and details from the beginning, middle and end of the book. Also, be sure that your letters are using the language of the character, conveying emotions experienced in response to events in the plot.

*The letters must be typed, double-spaced, 12-point font, in Times New Roman.
